Thank you for your enquiry about a Group Visit to Bentley Priory Museum.

Please pre-book visits for groups of more than 20 people.

For groups with minimum 20 people, group visits are available on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays. For groups with over 30 people, Tuesdays and Thursdays are also available to book a Group Visit.

Please note that group visits are not available during school holidays.

Bentley Priory is DDA Compliant as far as possible (within the restrictions of a historical building), with wheelchair access across the 2 floors of the Museum. A lift between floors is available. Please discuss any access requirements when arranging your visit with us.

Admission Charges

£8.00 Adult (£8.80 with gift aid)

£7.00 Concessions (over 60, students, on benefits) (£7.70 with gift aid)

£5.00 HM Forces and veterans (on production of I.D. or veteran's badge). (£5.50 with gift aid)

£4.00 Children aged 6 – 16 (£4.40 with gift aid)

FREE Children aged 5 and under free.

Carers who are supporting a visitor are admitted free.

March – September: 10:00 – 17:00 (Last Admission at 16:00)

October – February: 10:00 – 16:00 (Last Admission at 15:00)

Group Visit Payment

Payments for group bookings must be made as **one sum**, not individually.

Group Booking Form

Once a date for the Group Visit has been confirmed by the Museum, please complete and return the Group Booking Form. A £50 cheque deposit (refundable against admissions on the day of visit) is required at least one month before the visit. (Please note, once deposit is paid, if visit is cancelled the deposit is non-returnable).

Guided Tours

We are able to provide a guided tour for booked groups, if requested. At this time there is no charge for a guide, but this may be subject to review.

We offer a choice of two 1-hour long guided tours:

Bentley Priory and the Battle of Britain – This tour focuses on Bentley Priory's critical role as RAF HQ Fighter Command during the Battle of Britain in 1940.

Bentley Priory: The Evolution of an Historic House – This tour touches on Bentley Priory's role during the Battle of Britain, but also explores the wider history of the house, as a stately home, a royal residence, a hotel and even a girls' school!

Parking

Refreshments/Lunch

Our welcoming café overlooking the Italian Garden serves hot and cold drinks, snacks and hot food.

If you would like Afternoon Tea, a 50% cheque deposit is required one month before your visit. Please see the accompanying menus for options and prices.

An outdoor picnic area is also available.

Please note that once firm numbers have been given (minimum 1 week before the visit) the full cost of lunch or afternoon tea is payable, even in the event of cancellations.
